Supply list

You may use the medium of your choice, however the instructor will be demonstrating in

acrylic. Bring your usual painting supplies, a suggested list is as follows:

At least one painting surface per class: stretched canvas, canvas board, watercolor

paper, illustration board or your preference. It should be 16x20" or larger.

Sketch pad at least 9x12"

• Pencil, ruler, eraser, pencil sharpener, art or masking tape, scissors

Paints should include the primaries of yellow, red, blue as well as secondary colors of

orange, purple, green. White (gesso can be used) and black. Other colors you like.

• Palette can be a purchased commercial one, plastic white plates, butcher tray, freezer

paper, or your preference.

• Palette knives, water container, small spray bottle, paper towels (Viva preferred) tissue

and sponge

Bring an apron or wear old clothing that doesn't need protection.

• Synthetic brushes – one at least 1 inch wide, one round size 6 or higher, and one small

thin brush for detail work. They may be inexpensive but no hardware brushes.

Bring a matte, satin or gloss varnish with a brush – inexpensive – to finish your work.
