Paint: Mungyo Professional half pan watercolor set. You can get the 12 color set for \$11 on Amazon (allow at least 2 weeks for arrival).
Paper: 140 lb cold press watercolor paper pad or loose sheets at least 24 sheets
Plastic bowl for water
Fine tipped pencil for drawing
1 roll of paper towels
1 fine tipped black archival/permanent marker (Sharpie or equivalent)
1 small shaker of salt
Masking tape
Sponge (natural or artificial)
1 box of Crayons

Please feel free to substitute any items with what you may already own. If using watercolor paints from tubes you MUST have a paint palette with both wells and a lid. Example (Tom or Jane Jones Palette from Cheap Joe's Art supplies) Lid will provide easy transport as well as a surface for mixing paint. If they are older paints you may need pliers to open.

Additional items you may want to bring, but are not required: watercolor pencils, watercolor markers, any additional brushes or paints you may already own.
