Please bring whatever materials you're comfortable working with.

**Among your colors, please include Cadmium Lemon Yellow, Cobalt Blue, French Ultramarine and Ivory Black plus whatever selection of colors you're comfortable working with.*

**Bring photographic reference or sketches that you have created en Plein air and we'll work up a finished watercolor. Make sure all your reference has good light and shadow and/or interesting atmospheric effect as these make the best paintings.*

Watercolor Paint

It's a good idea to purchase only professional quality watercolor. Student grade paint, such as Cotman Watercolours and Grumbacher Academy, cost less but, tend to have less pigment - it's more expensive in the long run as you use more paint. Do not buy gouache or any color with hue in its name. Some of the better watercolor brands are listed below:
