Class description:

Palette knife painting is an exciting way to expressively and boldly paint nature. In this 6 hour workshop you will learn techniques with the palette knife and mediums to add to your acrylics to help them hold shape and texture. Our painting begins with a large brush and feathering method to create a smooth complementary color under painting on a 16" x 20" canvas. This is the perfect contrast to our large palm branches and earthy trunk, which we will paint with the palette knife. The painting is finished with a painted pastel blue sky. Your painting will be wet when you leave so be sure to bring a box for transport.
