## **Beginning Landscapes – Oil or Acrylic**

### **Supply List**

1 Flat 1" wide brush  
1 flat 1/2" wide brush  
1 #8 and #4 round brush  
pallet knife

### **Palette**

a butcher pan; sealed palette (or even a Styrofoam plate will do) there are many kinds to choose from. **Pick one that will suit you.**

### **2 Canvases**

You may purchase stretched and primed canvas or canvas boards.  
I also recommend getting a small pad of canvas paper when beginning as they are great and economical for testing colors when learning how to mix sophisticated colors.

### **PAINTS**

Titanium white, Cadmium red, Alizarin crimson, Cerulean blue, Ultramarine blue, Cadmium yellow, Yellow ochre, Hookers **or** Sap green, violet and Payne's grey.

**Optional** but highly recommended: Naples yellow and unbleached titanium white

### **The following items are for oil painters only**

**Linseed stand oil**

**Turpenoid**
